Denmark Special Individual Qualification required for 90 day permit exemption	Netherlands 6 weeks in 13 permit free
Finland Permit free for 90 days with invite or contract	Norway Permit free for 14 days
France Permit free for 90 days	Poland Permit free for 30 days
Germany Permit free for 90 days	Slovenia Permit free for 90 days
Hungary No permit needed	Sweden Permit free for 14 days with an invitation
